

Holiday Food Drive

If you've shopped for food recently you will probably attest to the fact that food costs have increased in the last few years. In fact, the latest data shows that food prices have risen a whopping 25.8% since 2020. To put that in perspective, a basket of groceries that cost \$100 in 2020 would now set you back \$125.80. The Center community is generous in so many ways. In the spirit of giving, we'll be collecting non-perishable food items that will be donated to the St. Peter Church pantry. This pantry serves almost 300 families in the area twice a month regardless of denomination or belief. Boxes designated for this collection will be in the Center office **through Wednesday, December 18**. A list of suggested food is printed below, no glass items or fresh food, please. **Help us by checking expiration dates. We will have to dispose of all expired products.** If anyone would rather make a cash donation, we will shop for you. Drop off an envelope in the Center office with your name and phone number on the outside and donation inside. You'll get a return call telling you what was purchased. Thank you!
