NEW Celtic Angels at Egyptian Theatre

On Sunday, April 6 a group will leave the Center at 1:45pm via a luxury coach bus to travel to the Egyptian Theatre in DeKalb where we'll experience the Celtic Angels Ireland at a 3:00pm live performance. Direct from Ireland, Irish traditional and contemporary tunes will be presented by the Celtic Angels, Trinity Ensemble, and the Celtic Knights Dancers. Weekend fun! The Egyptian Theatre has roots back to the age of the pharaohs. This historic structure owes this connection to the discovery of the tomb of King Tut in 1922. That discovery set off a nationwide interest in everything Egyptian. The Egyptian influence reached DeKalb County in 1928, when the DeKalb Theatre Company was trying to settle on a design for a combination motion picture house and vaudeville theatre. By the 1930s, the theatre was one of over 100 theatres across the country to decorate itself in an Egyptian style. With the theatre on the verge of being condemned in 1978, a group of citizens banded together to restore and save the Egyptian. The Egyptian was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1978. Of all the Egyptian theatres, the DeKalb theatre is one of only 7 remaining in the United States. Paid registrations (cash or a check made out to Geneva Township) are now being accepted. The cost (ticket and round-trip luxury coach bus transportation) is \$40. Sign up no later than Friday, March 28.

Tax Preparation Ending Soon

The AARP tax preparation appointment schedule is filling quickly. If you haven't made an appointment yet, call the Center soon to reserve a time. A handful of appointments remain in March and there are only five appointment days in April. The last day on the schedule is Tues., April 15. AARP tax preparation occurs on Tuesday and Thursday each week. Volunteer AARP income tax preparers will assist you in completing your 2024 Federal and IL tax returns. All returns are electronically filed. Most tax forms including 1040EZ, 1040A, and 1040 with schedules can be completed. A photo ID (driver's license, State ID, passport), social security card or Individual Taxpayer Identification notice, a copy of last year's tax returns, all income documents like W2's and 1099's, brokerage statements, and any other tax information specific to your situation must be presented at your appointment. If you'd like to save some time on the day of your appointment, the AARP Intake Booklet may be picked up in advance at the Center. This is a FREE service. However, no walk-ins; appointments are required. Call the Center (630/232-3602) soon to reserve a time slot.
